For the recognition of skills, acquired at other educational institutions and through professional activities, the responsible degree program committee has adopted the following regulations:

1. Recognition is possible following an examination, in which the competences acquired are determined.

These competence examinations are conducted by an authorized examiner in the presence of an assessor.

The examination can be conducted as a video conference.

The examiner and assessor must be in the same room.

The competency examinations are not graded; if the examination has been successful, the remark "passed" is included in the certificate.

2 A maximum of 30 ECTS can be recognized.

3. The successful completion of the certificate course offered by the Lübeck University of Applied Sciences - "Manager Regulatory Affairs" - can be credited to the Master's degree program "Regulatory Affairs" with 5 ECTS.

Participation in the first module "Introduction - Systematics and Legal Aspects" is then omitted.

The grade will not be transferred, instead the remark "passed" will be included in the certificate.

4. The crediting of competencies does not lead to a reduction in tuition fees.

Affected students have full access to all modules of the degree program in the TH "Lernraum".
